Mt. Morris Dam Tour & Lunch & Tour The Mills Mansion

When: Saturday, October 17th. We will meet at 8:30am at Lowes, 2350 Marketplace Drive, Henrietta and will depart for Mt Morris at 9am.

Where: Mt. Morris Dam, 6103 Visitor Center Drive, Mt. Morris, NY 14510

Lunch: Brian's USA Diner, 5524 Mt. Morris Rd., Mt. Morris, NY

What: Just think of how many times you have been to Letchworth State Park but never taken a tour of the Dam? Well this is your opportunity!



Members have 2 options on this journey – take a one mile walking tour of the Dam which takes one hour OR just hang out at the overlook. We will all tour the Visitor Center and see the excellent video on the Dam and the artwork on display. (GVACS will pay small fee for Dam tour.)

A maximum of 30 people are allowed on the tour so book your participation early.

*****Conditions of the Tour*****

To begin the tour, you must negotiate a steep 10% grade down to the Dam. Then you will enter the Dam which is cool (about 50 degrees) and wet. We highly recommend waterproof shoes

and a jacket. There is a 2 minute elevator ride to the guts of Dam and a tour.

After the tour is completed, there is a 10% grade back up to the Visitor Center and parking lot. If you believe you may have difficulty making this grade, please do not sign up for the tour.

Lunch: We hope to depart the Dam at 12:30 and drive to Brian's USA Diner on 5524 Mt Morris Rd, Mt Morris for lunch. We will order off the menu and get separate checks.

Mills Mansion Tour: After lunch, we have been invited to tour the Mills Mansion at 14 Main St, Mt Morris. Open 12-3pm. Gen. William Augustus Mills was the founder and first permanent white settler of Mount Morris.

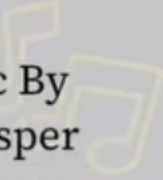

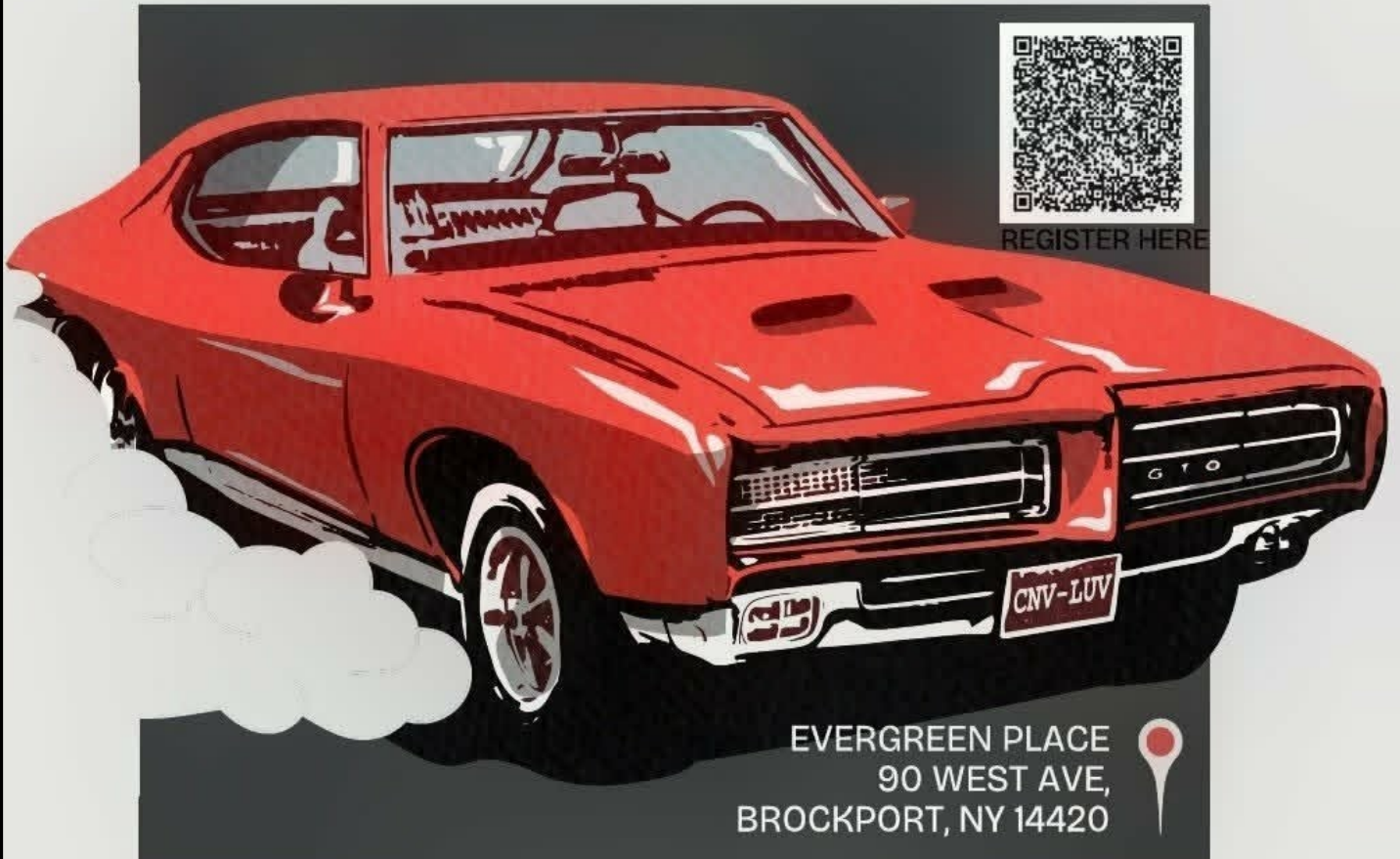
