



THE YEAR 1909, OVER 110 YEARS AGO - A Murray Stahl Muse

he average life expectancy was 47 years and a car's fuel was sold only in drug stores. There were only 8,000 cars traveling 144 miles of paved roads; the maximum speed limit was about 10 MPH.

The average wage was 22¢ an hour and an accountant would earn \$2,000 in a year to a

dentist's take of \$2,500. Over 90% of "Doctors" had no college education, in fact many barbers moonlighted as Doctors; yes, you read that right. The five leading causes of death were pneumonia, tuberdiarrhea, culosis, heart disease and strokes.



Marijuana, heroin, and morphine were all available over the counter at the local corner drugstores. Back then pharmacists said, "Heroin clears the complexion, gives buoyancy to the mind, regulates the stomach and bowels, and is, in fact, a perfect guardian of health."

Most women washed their hair using borax or egg yolks once a month; Only 14 percent of the homes

had a bathtub. Sugar cost 4¢ a pound, eggs 14¢ a dozen and coffee went for 15¢ a pound.

It was a far different time; Las Vegas Nevada had a population total of 30 and 22% of adults couldn't read or write; only 6% had graduated from high school. In the entire USA there were 230 reported murders. Roads were beyond bad hence the high

ground clearance on most cars of the era.

Canada passed a law that prohibited poor people from entering into their country for any reason.

The American flag had 45 stars. Crossword puzzles, canned beer, and iced tea hadn't

been invented yet.

There was no Mother's Day or Father's Day. Eighteen percent of households had at least one full-time servant or domestic help.

Plus, one more very sad thought; 95 percent of the taxes we have now did not even exist in 1909.
